





Miami-Dade Beacon Council closed projects with a record 57 companies in 2021-2022 -- nearly an 80% increase vs. prior year.



· Gains were consistent and strong across all MDBC target sectors, which saw at least a two-fold increase of the number of completed projects as compared to the prior year.

Close to 65% of FY21/22's projects were expansions and/or relocations by new-to-Miami companies.

Companies that are new to the Miami market are driving nearly 1,800 jobs, or about 65% of the new jobs created this year.

 New to Miami companies included three Miami - born startups: Alpha International Transport, LandQuire and Xennial Digital.



International interest and investment thrives, accounting for half of projects; Europe leads the way.

- While half of completed projects came from international markets, 10 states drove domestic expansions/relocations.
- Almost 60% of international projects came from Europe, while LATAM accounted for 35% and Australia/Asia for 5%.
- About 35% of international projects came from Spain, while Argentina, Brazil, Chile, and Israel followed with 7% each.
- New job creation by international companies was led by Spain and Colombia, each driving close to 20% of the new direct jobs generated for Miami-Dade.



Technology and Life Sciences & Healthcare account for lion's share of newly-created jobs.



- 3,101 new direct jobs were created by the companies that closed projects with MDBC over the past year. Total number of new jobs rises to 8,000 when indirect jobs induced by this development are factored in.
- Life Sciences & Healthcare and Technology led job creation, accounting for a combined 40% of new direct jobs.
- Finance and Trade & Logistics followed closely behind, accounting for 18% and 17% respectively, creating close to 1,100 new jobs combined.
- Creative industries, which includes woman-owned sustainable clothing and textile brand OSOM, led to the creation of nearly 150 new jobs.



Since 1985, The Beacon Council has assisted more than 1,300 businesses, working closely with them to provide free, confidential solutions that are customized for each company's unique needs. In 2021-2022, a record-breaking 57 commitments were secured from companies looking to expand or relocate to Greater Miami. The companies span diverse markets and industries, producing 8,000 new direct and indirect high-value jobs, and generating more than \$800 million of recurring annual economic impact for Miami-Dade County.







PROJECT PIOID Miami-Dade

Project Opioid Miami-Dade is an initiative that aligns business, nonprofit, faith, and philanthropic organizations to expand the table of advocates and concerned leaders committed to combatting the opioid epidemic. Participating partners across Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties, including The Beacon Council, aim to bring new energy, spark conversations, and convene the business community to support this ongoing effort.

Where we are:

- Launched on November 5, 2021. with over 200 participants engaged
- Created a tri-county plan with the Greater Fort Lauderdale Alliance acting as the administrative agency for Project Opioid South Florida
- Currently, we are facilitating a Community Response Team

(CRT) in Miami-Dade County with over 40 interested community leaders of business, non-profit, health, and law enforcement in South Florida to initiate the conversation of the epidemic. SMALL BUSINESS XCELERATOR

A Beacon Council Foundation Initiative

The Small Business XCELerator Program was launched during COVID-19 to support the most vulnerable businesses in Miami-Dade County. The program naturally supplements the existing entrepreneurial support ecosystem by partnering consultants who provide business growth and resiliency strategy services to small business owners throughout the county. During The 2021-2022 fiscal year, the SBX Program, in collaboration with our partners served 46 small businesses, providing over 200 hours of assistance. Through the program, entrepreneurs have addressed their lack of access to high-quality business services, marketing strategies, back-office organization, and technology. 


